NUTRITION:

Nutrition is the science that interprets the interaction of nutrients and other substances in food in relation to maintenance, growth, reproduction, health and disease of an organism. The diet of an organism is what it eats, which is largely determined by the availability, the processing and palatability of foods. A healthy diet includes preparation of food and storage methods that preserve nutrients from oxidation, heat or leaching, and that reduce risk of food borne illness.

OUR CAMPAIGN

"SWACHH NAGARIKA, SWACHH BHARAT"

Our NGO started a campaign "swachh nagarika, swachh bharat" inspired by the "swachh bharat abhiyan" introduced by the government of India. The campaign started from 2nd October, 2015. The objective of the campaign is to clean the streets & roads in the urban slum areas and to spread awareness among the underprivileged about hygiene which includes elimination of open defecation, segregation of wastes, awareness generation and health education to create a felt need for personal, household and environmental sanitation facilities.

AWARENESS DRIVE

We organized an event on personal hygiene and environmental cleanliness under our campaign "Swachh Nagarika, Swachh Bharat" near the slums of Gomtinagar extension, Lucknow where we gave lessons to the children about hygiene, cleanliness and sanitation. We taught them about how to wash hands, brush two times a day, bathe regularly, comb hairs properly, cut the nails often, dress up neatly, eat healthy, using toilet and elimination of open defecation, etc through short video clips and movies.

On April 25th, 2018, We visited Navjyoti school to encourage and motivate disabled students and distribute them fruits and sweets. It felt very soothing to see them smiling and hopeful. They played the harmonium and tabla beautifully and proved that nothing can hold them back not even their disability.

The prize distribution function of Women kabbadi league 2018 Uttar Pradesh was organised by Ansh welfare foundation at SRS Institute on May 3rd, 2018 in which Shalini Memorial Sewa Sansthan organised a group singing of National Anthem by girls

After the prize distribution, Shalini Memorial Sewa Sansthan and other organizations contributing to the success of the function were felicitated by the Honourable Sri Ram Naik, Governor of U.P. By doing so, we were trying to develop the personalities of the underprivileged children we sponsor through our NGO.

Shalini Memorial Sewa Sansthan wanted to add some flavour to the beautiful day of Khichdi by distributing Khichdi and various other essentials with it to the underprivileged children of the society. The smiling faces of these children make us feel special and proud of our efforts. We discussed about the importance of conserving natural resources and planting more and more trees for the betterment of our environment. We stressed on the importance of a clean and hygienic environment and water conservation by giving examples to the children and making them understand the value of a clean environment.

We planned to play Holi with eco-friendly colors with the deprived children and provide them with love, affection, compassion and care by distributing them sweets and snacks on 18th of March at G.S.M. Public School. As this festival is a big one, we wanted to be a part of these children's lives and make them feel special about themselves. So, we played colors with them, distributed Gujiyas, pastries, colors, pichkaris, art books, color box, champaks, and they danced on the tune of various holi songs, and motivated them to participate more and more in extracurricular activities and studies.

Shalini Memorial Sewa Sansthan believes that everyone deserves to be loved and cared. There are many such heart rendering stories of elderly people having been abandoned by their children and are now homeless. Our NGO wants to provide them with

It's a place of love, care, security, sustenance and nurturing. We want to help them build their life from scratch by giving them new environment, friends and support system for their day to day tasks and activities.
